



### **Abseil – Covid-19 Additional Health and Safety Procedures**

The following measures are being implemented at our abseil in line with government advice on social distancing. Please read these before attending the abseil so you are informed as to the relevant procedures that will be in place on the day:

- 1m+ social distancing rule in place at all times between anyone not from within same household
- Staff will be wearing visors/face coverings and gloves, where required, to adhere to the 1m+ rule
- Staff will have their temperature taken by the ArcelorMittal Orbit team on arrival. If their temperature is above 38 degrees, they will be asked to leave site.
- Staff will be asked to stay at home if displaying symptoms and isolate for 10 days as per current Government guidance
- Abseilers are advised that if they are feeling unwell / presenting any Covid-19 symptoms they must not attend the abseil, as per the Government guidelines
- Abseilers will have their temperature checked by the ArcelorMittal Orbit team on arrival. If their temperature is above 38 degrees, they will be asked to leave site
- Abseilers will be asked to clean/sanitise their hands before touching any equipment
- Abseilers will be provided with gloves to be worn whilst abseiling as per normal procedure
- Abseilers may wear a face covering providing there is no risk of entanglement with equipment, however this is not compulsory

There is a maximum of 5 abseilers that can book into each session, this is normal procedure but also allows for social distancing to be maintained throughout your abseil experience.
